

Using Your Sit and Stay Couch Protector & Washing Instructions

Thank you for purchasing the Stay in Place Protector. We hope that you and your pet enjoy it and use it to protect your couch for many years to come. Installing and removing the Protector is quick and easy. It will protect your couch's from dirt, fur, water and "accidents."

Step 1:

Remove the Protector from the plastic bag. Position the Protector so the guilted side is facing up. Locate the seam along the wide part of the Protector and place that seam along the section of couch where the seat cushion(s) meets the back rest. Center the Protector on top of the seat cushions, against and over the back rest and, over the arm rests.

Step 2:


Locate the rubber "handle anchors" on the underside of the Protector (there are four handles, except on the chair size which has three). These anchors help keep the Protector from shifting. Push the handles down between the seat cushions and back rest, and between the cushions and the arm rest.

Step 3:

Locate the fabric ties on the Protector's arms rest panels, and on the front and back panels. Attach the front panel ties to the front and back panel ties. This too will help stop the Protector from shifting.

Step 4:

This is the most important step - enjoy your four legged best friend sleeping comfortably on your couch (or is it 'their' couch?) knowing your couch will be well protected.



Washing Instructions:

Your Protector is fast and easy to clean. Wash and dry separately from other items. Wash the Protector with cold water on a delicate setting using a mild liquid laundry detergent, such as Woolite®.

Tumble machine dry on a cool setting. You may consider using a commercial grade front load washer and dryer.

Do not use bleach, and do not dry clean as these will damage the fabric.

In the event of a pet 'accident' remove the Protector immediately from the furniture. We recommend using an enzyme based urine treatment directly on the accident. Follow the directions on the urine treatment product.
