

Durable Pet Hammock



Installation and Washing Instructions

Thank you for purchasing the Durable Pet Hammock. Your four legged best friends will enjoy your hammock, and your backseat will remain clean and protected for years to come.

Installing, and removing, the hammock is quick and easy. The Durable Hammock installs over the backseat of your vehicle and requires front and back seat head restraint posts to install.

Step 1:

Remove the hammock from the plastic bag.

Position the hammock on the back seat so the heavy duty fabric side is facing up (note that the bottom of the hammock has small 'sticky' knobs on it to prevent slipping in tight corners). The seat belt pockets should be positioned against the back of the back seat to allow the seat belts to pass through the hammock.

Step 2:

Locate the two side release buckles that are on the top edge of the hammock towards the front seat. If necessary, raise the driver and passenger head restraints so you can get to the head restraint posts underneath. Undo the two side release buckles. Loop the webbing around the front seat head restraint posts. Reattach the two ends of the side release buckles.



Step 3:

The top of the hammock may hang down too far from the head restraint posts. Adjust the webbing straps that go around the head restraint posts to your desired tension. Loosening, or tightening, the webbing straps also adjusts the height of the hammock between the two front bucket seats. Some people prefer to keep the Hammock relatively tight between the two front seats to create a more substantial barrier between the front and back seats.

Step 4:

Locate the two side release buckles that are on the top edge of the hammock that rests against the back seat. Undo these two side release buckles. Just as with the head restraints on the front seat, loop the webbing straps around the posts that are under the head restraints on the back seats. Reattach the two ends of the side release buckles.

Adjust the height of the Hammock along the top of the backseat by adjusting the webbing straps through the side release buckles.

Step 5: People in the Back Seat

The hammock has openings that allow seat belts to be passed through the Hammock (an extra piece of fabric connected to the seat belt openings ensures that sand and dirt doesn't go through the Hammock into the backseat).

Washing Instructions:









The Durable Pet Hammock is fast and easy to clean.

Reattach all of the side release buckles.

Wash and dry separately from other items. Wash the hammock with cold water on a gentle setting using a mild laundry detergent. Tumble machine dry on a cool to warm setting. Do not use bleach, and do not dry clean as these may damage the heavy duty fabrics.

Alternatively, the hammock can be hosed off using a garden hose. Either hang the hammock to dry, or tumble machine dry on a cool to warm setting.

In the event of a pet 'accident', remove the hammock from the vehicle. We recommend using an enzyme based urine treatment directly on the accident. Allow the enzyme to dry completely before machine washing and drying the hammock. Should urine odors persist you can reapply the treatment and/or contact the enzyme manufacturer for further recommendations.
