

Durable Pet Seat Protector



Installation and Washing Instructions

Thank you for purchasing the Durable Pet Seat Protector. Your four legged best friends will enjoy your protector, and your backseat will remain clean and protected for years to come.

Installing, and removing, the protector is quick and easy. The Durable Protector installs over the backseat of your vehicle and requires back seat head restraint posts to install.

Step 1:

Remove the protector from the plastic bag.

Position the protector on the back seat so the heavy duty fabric side is facing up (note that the bottom of the protector has small 'sticky' knobs on it to prevent slipping in tight corners). The seat belt pockets should be positioned against the back of the back seat to allow the seat belts to pass through the protector.



Locate the two side release buckles that are on the top edge of the protector towards the back seat. If necessary, raise the driver and passenger side head restraints so you can get to the head restraint posts underneath. Undo the two side release buckles. Loop the webbing around the head restraint posts. Reattach the two ends of the side release buckles.

Step 3:

The top of the protector may hang down too far from the head restraint posts. Adjust the webbing straps that go around the head restraint posts to your desired tension. Loosening, or tightening, the webbing straps adjusts the height of the protector between the passenger and driver side of the back seat. Continued...

Step 4: People in the Back Seat

The protector has openings that allow seat belts to be passed through the protector (an extra piece of fabric connected to the seat belt openings ensures that sand and dirt doesn't go through the protector into the backseat).

Washing Instructions:









The Durable Pet Seat Protector is fast and easy to clean. Remove from the vehicle. Reattach all of the side release buckles.

Wash and dry separately from other items. Wash the protector with cold water on a gentle setting using a mild laundry detergent. Tumble machine dry on a cool to warm setting. Do not use bleach, and do not dry clean as these may damage the heavy duty fabrics.

Alternatively, the protector can be hosed off using a garden hose. Either hang the protector to dry, or tumble machine dry on a cool to warm setting.

In the event of a pet 'accident', remove the protector from the vehicle. We recommend using an enzyme based urine treatment directly on the accident. Allow the enzyme to dry completely before machine washing and drying the protector. Should urine odors persist you can reapply the treatment and/or contact the enzyme manufacturer for further recommendations.
