Putting Together Your Hide Out Bed & Washing Instructions

Thank you for purchasing the Hide Out Bed. Your four legged best friend will find the bed cozy and very comfortable. With proper care, your bed will provide years of happy use.

The bed is fast and easy to put together.

Step 1 – Putting the Bed Together:

The bed cover is packed separately from the stuffed pillows in the box.

Ensure that you have received: i) one bed cover; ii) one long stuffed bolster pillow (that fills the bottom bolster of the bed; iii) one shorter stuffed bolster pillow; iv.) one filled base (which is the cushion where your dog will lie down), v.) one zippered canopy (the top of the bed), and one plastic bag with extra compressed polyester fill.

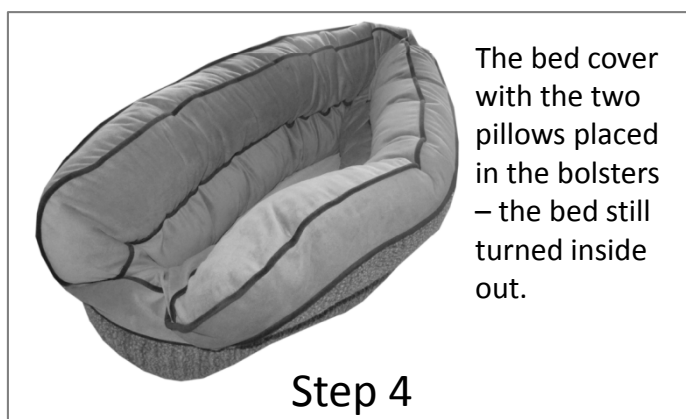
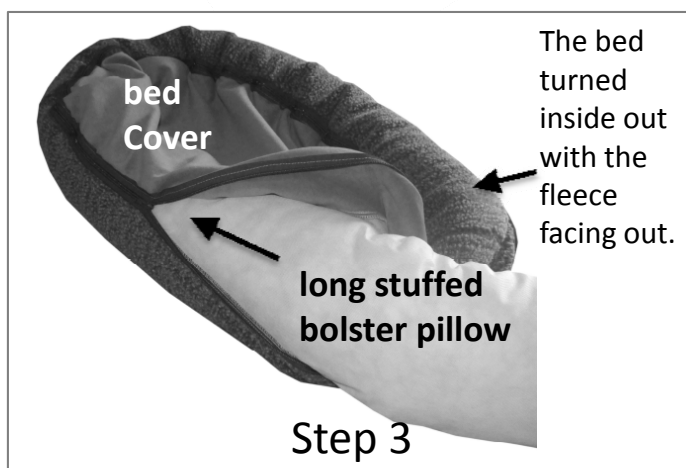
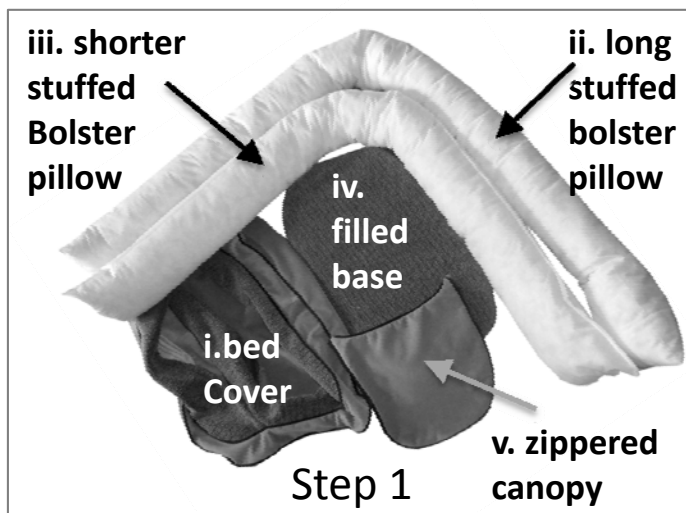
Step 2:

Open and decompress the two stuffed bolster liner pillows. Shake the long thin pillows allowing them to expand and evenly fill out the liner. (Note that it can take as long as 24 hours for the polyester fiber fill in the liners to fully expand.) If you want extra firmness in the bolsters, you can insert more polyester fill from the plastic bag with extra polyester fill.

Step 3:

Unfold the bed cover. It is easier to put the bolster liners into the cover with the bed cover turned inside out. The fleece on the bed cover should be facing out.

Find and open the bolster zippers on the bed cover. Work the longer bolster pillow into the bottom of the bed cover. Make sure the pillow goes all the way to the end of the bolster. Slowly close the zipper as you work the pillow into the bolster. Be sure to close the zippers slowly. **Continued on the back page...**

Step 3 Continued...

You may need to use both hands to close the zippers. Having someone else's help is even better. Have your helper hold the two sides of the zipper together as you gently close the zippers.

Step 4:

After you place the longer bolster pillow into the bottom bolster and close the zipper, place the shorter filled pillow into the second bolster. Make sure the pillow goes all the way to the end of the bolster. As you work the pillow in slowly and carefully close the zipper.

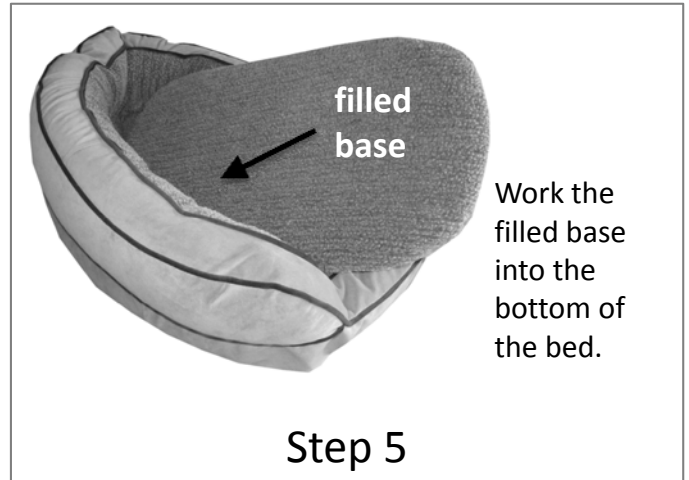
Step 5:

Flip the bed cover so it is no longer inside out (the bolster fleece should now be inside the bed). Work the filled base into the bottom of the bed. The base uses a polyester mat that will keep the bed shape. The bed is now ready for your best four legged friend to use.

FLAMMABILITY WARNING

Do not expose this product to open flames or any other direct source of indirect high temperature ignition sources, such as burning fire places, burning cigarettes, space heaters, or naked lights. Once ignited, polyester fiber will burn rapidly, releasing great heat and consuming oxygen at a high rate. In an enclosed space, the resulting lack of oxygen will present a danger of suffocation to the occupants. Hazardous gases released by the burning fiber can be incapacitating, or fatal, to human beings and pets if inhaled in sufficient quantities.

This warning applies to polyester fibers in general and they should not be construed that this bed is any more hazardous than those of other polyester fibers, or beds. All polyester fiber is dangerous if ignited.



Washing Instructions:

Your Hide Out Bed is fast and easy to wash and dry. The bed has zippered covers that must be removed before washing and drying.

Wash and dry separately from other items. The bed's liners, pillows and fill should not be washed.

Machine wash the covers with cold water on a gentle setting using a mild laundry detergent, such as Woolite®.

Tumble machine dry on a cool to warm setting. Do not use bleach, and do not dry clean as these will damage the upholstery grade fabrics.

In the event of a pet 'accident' on the bed we recommend using an enzyme based urine treatment directly on the accident. Follow the enzyme treatment instructions. For most treatments, allow the enzyme to dry completely before machine washing and drying the bed. Should urine odors persist you can reapply the treatment and/or contact the enzyme manufacturer for further recommendations.
