



Safety Backseat Extender



Installation and Washing Instructions

Thank you for purchasing the Safety Backseat Extender. On road trips the seat extender will help your dog be safer and more comfortable. With proper care, your seat extender will provide years of happy use.

Step 1:

The seat extender is designed to go in the backseat foot well between the back of the front seat in front of the back seat. This area is where humans would normally put their feet when they sit in the backseat.

Move the front seat forward as far as possible. Orient the seat extender with the narrow part of the extender pointing down. Place the extender in the foot well with the wide part of the extender pointing up.

You may need to push the extender into place.

Step 2:

Move the front seat back to where you want the seat to be. The front seat will push against and compress the seat extender securing it in place. Note that if the seat extender prevents the front seat from going as far back as you want, move the front seat forward, and flip the seat extender over so the narrow part of the extender faces up. This will give you more flexibility to move the front seat further back.

Note that you need two seat extenders to fill both foot wells in the back seat.

The Seat Extender is not suitable for use by, or for, children.



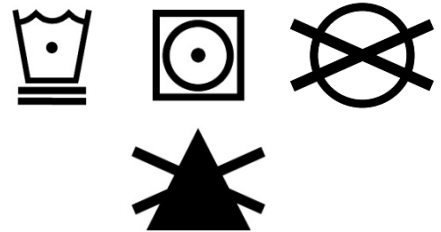
Washing Instructions:

The Safety Backseat Extender is fast and easy to clean.

The extender has a zippered cover and liner that must be removed before washing and drying. Wash and dry the cover and liner separately from other laundry items. Machine wash the cover and liner with cold water on a gentle setting using a mild laundry detergent, such as Woolite®. Tumble machine dry on a cool to warm setting. Do not use bleach, and do not dry clean as these will damage the upholstery grade fabrics.

The foam will absorb water and should not be washed, or hosed off.

In the event of a pet 'accident' we recommend using an enzyme based urine treatment on the accident.
